

## Two seriously hurt in horror crash near Wrexham Oct 6 2008 By Carl Butler Daily Post

**TWO people were seriously injured** in a horrific **two car collision** last night near Wrexham.

Up to three people were trapped in the crash which involved a **27-year-old** woman and her two month old baby.

The baby, who was strapped into a baby seat was uninjured, but taken to Wrexham Maelor Hospital for a check-up. It is believed the 27-year-old woman did not suffer serious injuries.

An 18-year-old male suffered multiple fractures and a 15-year-old front seat passenger was unconscious. One of the victims had to be carried away on a spinal board.

The crash happened on the A525 Wrexham to Marchwiel road near the Cross Lanes Hotel. about 10.30pm.

The PPP comments ... The immediate questions are, had anybody been drinking and/or taking drugs ?, was anybody NOT wearing a seat belt?, was an innocent motorist hit head on by a dangerous driver? Did either car have airbags and were they deployed?. The only good news seems to be that the mother has been protected within her vehicle and she had protected her baby by strapping her carefully into a properly fitted baby seat.
